RITE OF CONFIRMATION

Lighting of Baptismal Candles:

The sponsors are invited to stand in their place, holding their candle. Using a taper, designated adults take a flame from the Paschal candle and light each candle held by the sponsors. The sponsor sits after their candle is lit.

The sponsor (or proxy) should sit beside the candidate. Candles should not be lit in proximity to hand sanitiser.

Handing on the light of faith

Once all the names have been called, the Bishop now invites the sponsors to pass on the lighted candle to the candidate for the Renewal of Baptismal Promises. And both remain standing.

RENEWAL OF BAPTISMAL PROMISES

Bishop : Do you reject Satan and all his empty promises?

Candidates : I do.

Bishop : Do you believe in God the Father almighty,

creator of heaven and earth?

Candidates : I do.

Bishop : Do you believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our

Lord, who was born of the Virgin Mary, was crucified, died, and was buried, rose from the dead, and is now seated at the right hand of the

Father?

Candidates : I do.

Bishop : Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the

giver of life, who came upon the apostles at Pentecost and today is given to you sacramentally

in Confirmation?

Candidates : I do.

Bishop : Do you believe in the Holy Catholic Church, the

communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting?

Candidates : I do.

Bishop confirms their profession of faith by proclaiming the faith of the Church:

Bishop : This is our faith. This is the faith of the Church.

We are proud to profess it in Christ Jesus our

Lord.

All : Amen.

Candidates and sponsor remain standing

THE LAYING ON OF HANDS

Facing the people with his hands joined, Bishop now says:

Bishop: My dear friends: in Baptism God our Father gave the new birth of eternal life to His chosen sons and daughters. Let us pray to our Father that He will pour out the Holy Spirit to strengthen His sons and daughters with His gifts and anoint them to be more like Christ the Son of God.

All pray in silence for a short time.

The Bishop and the priests now extend their hands over the candidates and pray that God will send this Holy Spirit upon them to be their helper and their guide.

With hands outstretched, the Bishop alone sings or says:

Bishop : All-powerful God, Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, by water and the Holy Spirit You freed Your sons and

daughters from sin and gave them new life. Send Your

Holy Spirit upon them to be their Helper and Guide.

Give them the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of right judgment and courage, the Spirit of knowledge and reverence. Fill them with the Spirit of wonder and awe in Your presence. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

All : Amen.

THE ANOINTING WITH CHRISM

Wearing a face covering, the Bishop takes the tray with chrism, dish of cotton buds and dish for disposal of cotton buds. The candidate is now invited to hand back the Baptismal Candle to their sponsor and remains standing in their place to await the approach of the Bishop to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. The candidate should be seated at the end of the pew nearest the aisle, holding their Confirmation card.

During the anointing, a suitable hymn may be sung.

The Bishop dips the cotton bud in the Chrism and makes the sign of cross on the forehead of the one to be confirmed, as he says:

Bishop : N., be sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit.

Candidate : Amen.

Bishop : Peace, be with you.
Candidate : **And with your spirit**

INTERCESSIONS

(LET US STAND)

Response: Lord, graciously hear us.

Bishop : My dear friends: let us be one in prayer to God our Father as we are one in the faith, hope, and love his Spirit gives.

- 1. For the holy People of God, in union with Francis our Pope and Kevin our Bishop, that God, who gathers us together by the Holy Spirit may help us grow in unity of faith and love until his Son returns in glory. **Lord, hear us.**
- 2. For all people, of every race and nation, that they may acknowledge the one God as Father, and in the bond of common fellowship, seek his kingdom, which is peace and joy in the Holy Spirit. **Lord, hear us.**

hallowed be Thy name;
Thy kingdom come,
Thy will be done
on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread,
and forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against us;
and lead us not into temptation,
but deliver us from evil.

With hands extended, the Bishop alone continues, saying:

Deliver us, Lord, we pray, from every evil,
graciously grant peace in our days,
that, by the help of Your mercy,

He joins his hands.
The people conclude the prayer, acclaiming:

The Bishop genuflects, takes the host and, holding it slightly raised above the paten or above the chalice, while facing the people, says aloud:

All respond:

Lord, I am not worthy that You should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.

After this, he takes the paten or ciborium and approaches the communicants.

The Bishop raises a host slightly and shows it to each of the communicants, saying:

The Body of Christ.

The communicant replies:

Amen.
