

MARRIAGE INFORMATION

Getting Married in the Church

What is needed?

- The first thing a couple needs to do is to contact the local parish clergy.
- The Church where they wish to marry must also be booked.

The Pre-Nuptial Enquiry Forms should be completed, for which the following are required:

- Baptism and Confirmation Certificates.
- Proof of Freedom to marry.
- Marriage Preparation Certificate.
- Permissions and dispensations where applicable.
- If either party has been previously married, it is essential that freedom to marry be established before any marriage arrangements are confirmed.

Check List

What the Couple Must Do:

- Contact the priest chosen to preside at the wedding ceremony (Solemniser).
- Meet the priest to complete the paperwork.
- Book the Church where they wish to marry.
- Attend Pre-Marriage Course.
- Meet a civil registrar at least 3 months before the wedding to give notice of their intention to marry.
- Receive the Marriage Registration Form (MRF) from the Civil Registrar.
- Bring the MRF to the Solemniser.
- Make the verbal declaration of no civil impediment not more than 2 days before the wedding.
- Return the signed MRF to any Civil Registrar not later than 1 month after the wedding.

Important Hints

- Inform the officiating priest of the date and time of your wedding.
- To avoid any confusion include the officiating priest's name, address and contact number on your Booking Form.
- Each couple is to see their own local priest for preparatory paper work. He will forward the completed paperwork to our Parish office.
- Attend a Pre-marriage course ideally 5 months before your wedding. The Accord Course and the Redemptorist Course in Athenry are the only Courses approved by our Diocese. contact details: Accord, Charles Street, Sligo, Tel: 071 914 5641 website: www.accord.ie email: accordsligo@eircom.net

- Legal Civil Requirement is at least 3 months notice to The Office of Births/ Marriages/Deaths, Markievicz House, Sligo.
- Choose appropriate Sacred/ Religious Music for the ceremony.
- Stipends to Sacristans are payable directly on the day of marriage.
- Choose Readings/ Ceremony Texts with the officiating priest and arrange a practice with him before the marriage day.
- Marriage ceremonies must commence on time.
- Photography/ videography to be used discreetly. Please take care not to have dazzling lights.
